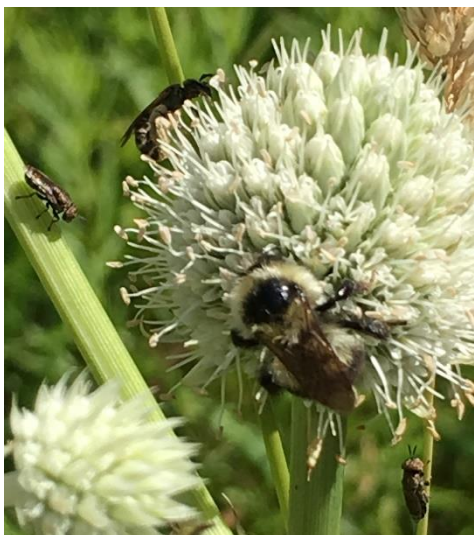

Their numbers are declining, however, due to habitat loss, pests, diseases, pesticides, and climate change.
